OAG partnership agreement with FNU

The Office of the Auditor General has signed a Memorandum of Agreement with the Fiji National University to reward the most outstanding postgraduate auditing student.

The reward will be given during FNU's two graduation Ceremonies for the next three years commencing from December 2018.

While signing the agreement, the Auditor-General, Mr. Ajay Nand said this partnership renews the relationship of the two organizations.



The Auditor-General said **"FNU is an institution of national importance. Prior to the establishment of FNU, the Auditor-General was the external Auditor for five of the colleges which are now part of FNU"**.

He further mentioned that **"through this partnership, they intend to create awareness on the roles of Office of the Auditor-General not only to thousands of students who graduate from the University but to friends and relatives who attend the graduation ceremonies as well"**.

Also speaking at the signing the FNU Vice Chancellor, Professor Nigel Healey emphasized on the importance of auditing in this fast developing world.

Professor Healey said auditing has become a crucial function in maintaining confidence in the modern sophisticated financial structure.

The signing of the Memorandum of Agreement took place last Tuesday 30 October 2018.
