Delegates from over 30 Offices of the Auditors General will meet next week for the 28th Meeting of the INTOSAI WGITA

The Office of the Auditor General for the Republic of Fiji will be hosting the 28th meeting of the International Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions (INTOSAI) Working Group on IT Audit (WGITA) and the 9th Performance Audit Seminar, from the 2nd – 5th of April, 2019.

His Excellency the President, Major-General (Ret'd) Jioji Konusi Konrote, will officially open the meeting on 2nd April 2019 at the Sofitel Fiji Resort & Spa.

The event will be attended by delegates from Supreme Audit Institutions or Offices of the Auditors General from over 30 countries and from organisations affiliated to the INTOSAI. This is the first time the Fiji Office of the Auditor General, which is a member of the working group, is hosting the meeting.

The Performance Audit Seminar provides a platform for Supreme Audit Institutions or the INTOSAI Community to discuss and share their knowledge on the theme "IT Security Audit". The representatives from Auditors General's Offices from the USA, Australia, Estonia, Kuwait, Afghanistan, Sudan, Samoa, India, Hungary, Japan, South Korea, South Africa, Georgia and the Philippines are expected to share their experiences on the chosen theme.

The WGITA, which has a membership of 48 countries, is currently chaired by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, Mr Rajiv Mehrishi.
