Office of the Auditor-General to host the 22nd PASAI Congress

The 22nd PASAI Congress will be officially opened by the Speaker of Parliament Honourable Ratu Epeli Nailatikau on the 13th of August.

The Congress together with the 21st Governing Board meeting will be held at the InterContinental Fiji Golf Resort & Spa and will be catering for more than 55 international delegates from around the world and PASAI member countries.

The theme for the 22nd PASAI Congress is “SAI’s Contribution to Sustainable Development Goals”.

The Auditor-General of Fiji Mr. Ajay Nand says “22nd PASAI Congress will provide a good opportunity for delegates to share knowledge and ideas on their approaches to the Sustainable Development Goals.

Mr Nand will also Chair the 22nd PASAI Congress that would be handed over by Mr. Grant Hehir, the Auditor-General for Australia as Chairperson for the 21st PASAI Congress.

PASAI is one of the regional working groups affiliated to the International Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions and is made up of 27 member SAI’s which promotes transparent, accountable, effective, and efficient use of public sector resources in the Pacific.
