Senior Auditors and Managers of the Office of the Auditor-General (OAG) learn about “Leadership styles that get results”.

The Senior Auditors from the Office of the Auditor-General Republic of Fiji (OAG) are currently attending a training program titled “Leadership Training on Embedding and Extending Leadership Effectiveness” from the 4th – 6th November, 2019.

This training is focused on “Leadership styles that get results.”

Mr. Marshall Cowley who is the training facilitator has been engaged by The Tasmanian Audit Office (TAO). The three day training is part of the TAO and the Office twinning program.

While opening the leadership training workshop, the Auditor-General Mr. Ajay Nand said his “key expectation from the workshop is for our leadership to employ our primary resource effectively and efficiently to deliver the mandate of the Auditor-General in a timely manner and of excellent quality”.

Mr. Nand highlighted that the primary reason for bringing this training to the OAG middle management level was to equip them the necessary soft skill training. Such training would eventually allow them to effectively communicate better.

A similar workshop was held for the OAG Executive Management in October 2018 where they developed action plans and made commitments to deliver these.

The three days training is being held at the Suva Business Centre.
