### XXIV Commonwealth Auditors-General Conference

The Office of the Auditor-General of the Republic of Fiji will host the XXIV Commonwealth Auditors-General Conference from 26 to 28 May, 2020. The Conference will bring together Heads of Supreme Audit Institutions and their delegates from across the fifty three Commonwealth member countries, at the Sofitel Fiji Resort & Spa in Nadi.

With the conference theme “**Emerging Issues & Future Challenges**”, presentations and discussions will center on how Supreme Audit Institutions (SAIs) can continue to ensure their relevance as institutions of great value to society. Modern circumstances call for quality of audit work, new audit approaches and require SAIs to rethink their roles in the governmental accountability process.

Since 1951, the Auditors-General of the Commonwealth have met every three years to engage in discussions on issues affecting public sector auditing and matters of mutual professional interests and concerns.

The previous conference, being the XXIII Conference, was held in New Delhi, India in 2017.
